According to several legislators, insurance companies are mysteriously using credit scores, prior history of water damage and large payouts in other states to justify higher premiums. With issues surrounding the United States on terrorism and disaster, we need to inform homeowner's on issues that protect them from damage that may affect the value of their home and other personal property.
